


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Welcome to Bloom Drum Breaks

Thank you for purchasing Bloom Drum Breaks. Within, you will find a playable drum breaks instrument that combines drum loops, one-shots and phrases with a set of effects & macros, a comprehensive sample editor and a unique phrase player engine.

Installation & Activation


If you have purchased a perpetual license, you can download the plugin from the 'My Account' page within your <u>Plugin Boutique User Account</u>, install the product and enter the 16-digit license key, also available within your Plugin Boutique account.

If you have purchased on Rent to Own or via Beatport Studio, the plugin can be downloaded, installed and activated entirely through the Beatport Access manager app. To do this, follow these steps:

- Go to your <u>Plugin Boutique User Account</u> and open the **Rent To Own** or **My** Subscriptions tab. Click **Download** to download the Beatport Access app.
 Install and open the application.
- Go to the Rent To Own or Beatport Studio tab. Locate the product and click Download. Open the downloaded .pkg (macOS) or .exe (PC) installer and follow the steps to install the plugin.
- Leave the Beatport Access application running and open the plugin within your DAW. Your plugin is now installed, activated and ready to use.

The Main Page

The main page contains the core controls for loading & playing samples, loading presets, selecting the key, and transforming the sound using the pre-designed macros and single effects.



Top Bar Navigation



Arrows: Navigate to the previous or next preset.

Heart Icon: Click to add this preset to your favourites.

Preset Bar: Click to open the preset browser.

Save Icon: Save the current plugin settings as a new preset.

i lcon: Turn the tooltips on or off.

Edit: Click to open the edit page.


Output Slider: Click and drag to adjust the global output volume.

Arrow Button: Click the arrow to turn on velocity sensitivity. When turned on,

the plugin will respond to the velocity of the MIDI input.

Excite Audio logo: Click to open the plugin's activation window.

Macros & Animation



Macro 1: Digital - Add digital bitcrushing-style distortion to the audio.

Macro 2: *Lo-Fi* - Create a vintage lo-fi effect.

Animation: The visual animation reacts dynamically to the audio.

Macro 3: Slap Verb - Add a slap delay that transitions into a reverb.

Macro 4: Phaser - Add a phasing effect to the audio.

Bottom Bar Navigation



Musical Note & C Maj: Click to open the key selector tool.

Bars Icon: Click to display the full set of sample banks.

White Keys: Press a white key on your MIDI keyboard or click the key on the user interface to trigger a sample.

Right-click: Right-click a white key to copy & paste a sample and all of its settings to another white key.

Dice Icon (Randomise): Click to randomise the selection of samples mapped to the white keys.

FX Icon: Click to open the FX panel.

Modifier Keys



Hold this key down whilst triggering a sample to play back in half time.



Hold this key down whilst triggering a sample to play back in double time.



Hold this key down whilst triggering a sample to play back in reverse.



Hold this key down whilst triggering a sample to play back one octave lower.



Hold this key down whilst triggering a sample to play back one octave higher.



Hold this key down to trigger the phrase mapped to Modifier A, B, C, D or E.

Key Selector

Use the Key Selector tool to set the key for the entire instrument, to match the key of the project you are working in.




Major: Display all the major keys.

Minor: Display all the relative minor keys.


Octave: Pitch the entire instrument up or down by an octave.

Bank Selector

Use the bank selector page to load samples and banks onto the keyboard. Preview a sample in any bank by clicking the white triangle key in the bank, then click and drag it onto a slot in the bottom keyboard to load the sample onto a white key.



Click and drag the bank handle to drag & drop an entire bank onto the keyboard.



Effects



Saturation: Add a smooth saturation effect to the audio. This control is linked to the Mix control on the Saturation module in the Edit page.

Dynamic: Adjust the dynamics of the audio. This control is linked to the Mix control on the Dynamic module in the Edit page.

Noise: Add a noise layer to the audio. This control is linked to the Level control on the Noise module in the Edit page.

Lo-Cut: Cut out frequencies below the set frequency level.

Hi-Cut: Cut out frequencies above the set frequency level.


The Edit Page

From the Edit page, you can tweak, create phrases with, and apply effects to the 14 samples that are loaded onto the white keys.




Sample Edit Section

Here you can select one of the 14 loaded samples and edit their playback settings, set start and end points, and edit each sample's parameters.



Playback Settings & Modes



Keyboard Icon: Turn this on to use MIDI input to select which sample to edit in the sample editor.

Numbered Dropdown: Select which of the 14 samples to edit.

Playback: Set the sample playback mode to Hold, Latch or Relative.

Hold - Play the sample whilst the note is held down.

Latch - Press the note once to play the entire sample.

Relative - The sample starts playing from the position of where the previous sample finished playing.

Speed: Set the playback speed to normal, half-time or double-time.


Choke: Assign the sample to a choke group. Any samples assigned to the same choke group will stop each other's playback.

Forwards / Backwards Icons: Start playing the sample forwards or backwards.

Pendulum Icon: Play the sample in both directions.

Loop Icon: Loop the sample continuously.

Edit Window



Sample Markers: Set the start and end points for the sample.

Snap: Snap the markers to the grid or the transients, or turn snapping off.

Grid: Adjust the time divisions on the grid.

Fade: Adjust the fade time of the sample. When sample loop is turned OFF, the sample will fade out. When sample loop is turned ON, the start and end points will crossfade as the samples loops.

Parameters



Attack: Increase or decrease the attack time of the sample in ms.

Release: Increase or decrease the release time of the sample in ms.

Pan: Pan the sample to the left or right in the stereo field.

Volume: Adjust the overall volume of the sample in dB.

Pitch Warp: Warp the pitch of the sample as the BPM changes.

Pitch: Shift the pitch of the sample up or down in semitones.

Fine: Shift the pitch of the sample up or down in cents.


Formant: Change the formant of the sample.

Right-click: Right-click any parameter to apply the same settings to all 14 samples. Right-click in an empty space to copy or paste all of the sample settings.


Phrase Player Section

Within this section, you can design Phrases with both the loaded samples, and the effects options listed on the left-hand side of the Phrase Player window.

Set different samples to play over each step of the phrase and design effects, pitch & velocity to evolve and morph over time as you play samples.



Sample & Effects Modes & Playback Modes



Key Select Dropdown Menu: Select which key to trigger the phrase player.

Sample Mode: Set a different sample to play on each step of the phrase.

Saturation Mode: Set the amount of saturation effect for each step of the phrase. The phrase player is connected to the Mix control on the Saturation module.

Pitch Mode: Set the pitch for each step of the phrase.

Dynamic Mode: Set the amount of dynamic effect for each step of the phrase.

The phrase player is connected to the Mix control on the Dynamic module.

Velocity Mode: Set the velocity level for each step of the phrase.

Noise Mode: Set the amount of noise for each step of the phrase. The phrase player is connected to the Level control on the Noise module.

Lo-Cut Mode: Set the lo-cut cutoff frequency for each step of the phrase.

Hi-Cut Mode: Set the hi-cut cutoff frequency for each step of the phrase.


Forwards / Backwards Icons: Start playing the phrase either forwards or backwards.

Pendulum Icon: Play the phrase in both directions.

Loop Icon: Loop the phrase continuously.

Dice Icon (Randomise): Randomise the settings within the phrase.

Phrase Designer - Sample Mode




Sample Number: Set which sample is triggered in each step.

Dark Red Dragger Handle: Drag this across the steps to set the number of steps the sample plays for in the phrase. The shaded area over each step indicates which steps the sample plays over.

Hold / Latch / Relative Icon: This displays if a sample is set to play back in Hold, Latch or Relative mode.

Step Numbers: This displays which step the phrase is currently at when playing.

Phrase Designer - Effects, Velocity & Filter Modes



White Circle Node: Click & drag up, down, left and right to set the position.

Double-click on the coloured line to add a new node and double-click a node to delete it.

Red Square Node: Click & drag up and down to curve the line between two White Circle Nodes.


Step Numbers: This displays which step the phrase is currently at.

Right-click: Right-click to either copy the modulation settings, paste the modulation settings from another phrase, or clear the modulation settings.

Keyboard Shortcut 1: Hold Shift and click and drag a White Circle Node to snap it horizontally to the grid.

Keyboard Shortcut 1: Hold Alt and click and drag a White Circle Node to snap it vertically to the closest node above or below it.

Phrase Settings



Rate: Set the rate of the phrase player.

Sync: Sync the rate of the phrase player to the host.

Swing: Add swing to each step of the phrase player.

Steps: Set the number of steps in the phrase.

Latch: Keep the phrase playing until the modifier key is pressed again.

Beat: Set the phrase to retrigger every set number of beats/bars.

Beat Number Selector: Set the retrigger interval in beats/bars.

Effects Section

Within this section, you can fine-tune the effects settings. There is a specific control on each module that corresponds to both the Phrase Player and the single FX controls on the Main Page.



Draggable Handle: Click & drag this to reorder the effects in the signal chain.

Bypass Toggle: Turn the effect on or off.

X Icon: Click this to collapse and expand the effect panel to display or hide additional controls.

Saturation



Mode Select: Select the type of saturation.

Tape - Smooth tape-style saturation that adds glue and fullness to the audio.

Tube - Warm tube-style distortion with an analogue feel.

Fuzz - Heavy, aggressive guitar pedal style distortion that adds harmonic overtones.

Drive: Adjust the amount of drive.

Dynamic: Focus the saturation to the transients to retain dynamics in the signal.

Mix: Adjust the mix between the dry and wet signal.

Amount: Adjust the amount of feedback.

Freq: Set the frequency of the feedback signal.

Tone: Adjust the tonal balance of the saturation.

In: Adjust the input level in dB.

Out: Adjust the output level in dB.

Dynamics



Attack: Increase or decrease the attack of the initial transient.

Sustain: Adjust the volume of the body of the signal, after the initial transient.

Mix: Adjust the mix between the dry and wet signal.

Gate: Set the trigger level of the noise gate.

Comp: Adjust the amount of compression applied to the signal.

Attack: Set the attack time for the compressor in ms.

Release: Set the release time for the compressor in ms.

In: Adjust the input level in dB.

Out: Adjust the output level in dB.

Noise



Mode Select: Select the mode for the noise to operate in.

Constant - Consistently layer the noise on top of the signal. The noise will only be audible when playing back in the DAW.

Dynamic - Apply the noise dynamically to the signal.

Ducked - Duck the noise signal volume down when the dry signal plays.

Source: Select the type of noise.

Level: Adjust the level of the Noise signal.

Threshold: Set the threshold level of the noise to be triggered.

Release: Set the release time for the noise.

Tone: Adjust the tonal balance of the noise.

In: Adjust the input level in dB.

Out: Adjust the output level in dB.

Global



Lo: Cut out frequencies from the global wet signal below the set frequency.

Hi: Cut out frequencies from the global wet signal above the set frequency.

Tone: Control the overall tonal balance of the global signal.

Dry: Adjust the level of the global dry signal.

Wet: Adjust the level of the global wet signal.

Macro 1: Digital - Add digital bitcrushing-style distortion to the audio.

Macro 2: Lo-Fi - Create a vintage lo-fi effect.

Macro 3: Slap Verb - Add a slap delay that transitions into a reverb.

Macro 4: Phaser - Add a phasing effect to the audio.
